Q2. Does Hitotsubashi University offer English-medium degree programs for undergraduate students?

Although we have some classes conducted in English, the University does not offer English-only undergraduate programs at present. The entrance examination will be conducted in Japanese, and the application documents, including information about eligibility to apply, application materials, etc., are provided in Japanese only.

Q3. What is the admissions schedule at Hitotsubashi University?

The undergraduate entrance examination for Hitotsubashi University is for spring admission only. Details of the application procedure are made available around September - October, and the application process for privately financed international students starts in December. The entrance examination takes place around the end of January.

Q4. What are the application requirements and test subjects for the entrance examination?

For details, please refer to the application procedures on the website below. The application documents are subject to change each year, so please be sure to refer to the documents for the year in which you are applying.

For your information, the following two examinations are required for applications from privately financed international students, and you must obtain at least the minimum score on each test:

1) Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU):
Japanese as a Foreign Language (except Writing section), Japan and the World,
Mathematics (Course 1): total 680 or above.

2) TOEFL-iBT: 48 or above.

In addition to the tests above, you will need to take Hitotsubashi University's own Japanese language exam.

Q5. Can I transfer onto the Hitotsubashi University undergraduate program from an overseas university?

Entrance examination fee: ¥17,000

Admission fee: ¥282,000

Tuition fee: ¥321,480 per semester (¥642,960 per year)
